# **Rising Star Camp**

Rising Star Camp is a structured day camp specifically designed to promote self-esteem, conflict resolution skills, positive interactions and success in its participants.

Rising Star Camp's unique program accommodates boys and girls ages 6-13 who may not have had the opportunity to attend day camp. This program is also designed to support children who have struggled with the traditional day camp experience.

## Our Camp

- located at Elks Pond in Torrington
- 1:6 staff to child ratio
- Goal setting: Campers create a personal goal each morning with their counselor and are provided time at the end of the day to discuss the progress made towards their goal.
- Each day campers earn stickers with good choices/positive participation in camp activities. Earned stickers can be spent at the weekly "Sticker Store"

RSC relies on small groups and a dedicated, experienced staff to ensure success and a safe summer. We offer two-week sessions, for **boys and girls ages 6-13**. We support up to **40** participants per two-week session. Each child may attend for a *maximum of two sessions* during the summer so we may give as many children as possible the opportunity to attend.

#### 2024 RSC Tuition

Rising Star Camp tuition is \$510 for each two-week session. A non-refundable \$50 deposit is required for each session the camper will attend. Deposit is due at time of registration.

#### **Financial Assistance**

We believe that every child deserves the opportunity to enjoy the Rising Star Camp experience and understand that families have different abilities to pay for camp. We strive to make camp attainable for all through our financial assistance program.

We will consider your annual income, the number of adults and dependents in your household, and then determine assistance to align with your individual situation. Our goal is to help everyone who qualifies for assistance.
